

ORDINANCE NO. 500

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 471,
THE MANTOLOKING BOROUGH SALARY ORDINANCE,
REVISING SALARIES FOR THE DEPUTY MUNICIPAL COURT ADMINISTRATOR,
COURT PERSONNEL CALL-OUT TIME (HOURLY) AND CREATING THE POSITION
OF MUNICIPAL COURT VIOLATIONS CLERK AND THE SALARY FOR
SAID OFFICE IN THE BOROUGH OF MANTOLOKING, OCEAN COUNTY, NEW
JERSEY**

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the governing body to amend the provisions of Ordinance 471, adopted January 20, 2004.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mantoloking, Ocean County, New Jersey, as follows:

1. Section 3 is amended by:
 - (a) deletion of the salary range for the position of Deputy Municipal Court Administrator and addition of the following:
“Deputy Municipal Court Administrator
Hourly, range \$10.00 to \$20.00”;
 - (b) The addition of:
“Municipal Court Violations Clerk
Compensation not to exceed \$100.00 per court session”;
 - (c) The deletion of the salary range for Court Personnel Call-Out Time and the addition of the following:
“Court Personnel Call-Out Time (hourly – minimum 3 hours), not to exceed \$20.00 per hour”.
2. The position of Municipal Court Violations Clerk is hereby established.

3. All of the provisions of Ordinance No. 471, not specifically amended by this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

4. If any part or portion of this Ordinance shall be adjudicated invalid by a Court having jurisdiction, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

5. This Ordinance shall become effective upon final adoption.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the foregoing Ordinance was introduced and passed upon first reading at a regular meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mantoloking, in the County of Ocean and State of New Jersey held on the 19th day of September, 2005, and said Ordinance will be considered for final passage at the Borough Hall, Downer Avenue, Mantoloking, New Jersey at 8:00 p.m. on the 17th day of October, 2005, or as soon thereafter as said matter may be reached, at which time and place all persons interested will be given an opportunity to be heard.
