Subject: Dune Maintenance Advisory

Dear Oceanfront Homeowners:

Please be advised that minor repairs to the toe of the Borough's dune system will be conducted throughout the winter as sufficient amounts of beach sand became available for bulldozing activities. The interim repairs at the critical dune areas indicated in our December 2, 2009 Summary of Sustained Damage report (report and map available at Borough Hall) were completed by January 5, 2010. The Borough will now be progressing with the repairs to the balance of the dune system to halt the continuing slumping of the dune scarp caused by the storm we experienced between November 12 and 16, 2009.

Please be aware that the repairs being conducted at this time are to stabilize the dune face and reduce the severity of the dune foreslope. Bulldozing efforts to rebuild the dune system to pre-fall 2009 conditions are anticipated to commence in early to late spring of 2010 as the beach berm is fully replenished from the sandbars just off shore. Prior to that time all Permits are to be completed by the oceanfront homeowners and submitted to the Borough for this mandatory effort.
