## **HOUSEHOLD TRASH & GARBAGE PICK-UP**

### **SECTION #1**

**Monday and Thursday**

**BACK DOOR PICKUP ALLOWS THREE (3) CONTAINERS** of household waste per pick-up day. May include one (1) container of occupant generated building or construction waste no more than 4 feet in length. **All containers are to be no more than 50 gal. capacity and weigh less than 50 lbs.** All excess containers of waste are to be placed at the curb. Cardboard boxes are to be broken down and placed at curbside!

### **SECTION #2**

**Tuesday and Friday**

**Independent contractors, builders, landscapers and painters must dispose of their own waste. No dock lumber, bulkhead lumber or decking will be accepted.**

### **ADDITIONAL CURBSIDE PICK-UP ITEMS**

The following items will be collected on the **collection days of your trash/garbage schedule**, and they **must be placed at the curb**.

1. Bagged or tied clippings, grass, leaves, small branches, and yard waste. Bundles must be less than 4 feet in length and weigh less than 40 lbs. Real Christmas trees will be picked-up whole by the Borough Public Works Department.
2. Household/patio furniture, mattresses, television sets, stereo equipment & electronic equipment, etc. (See Bulk Pick-Up directions on page 2.)
3. Carpet and Flooring must be cut, rolled, and tied in lengths no longer than 4 feet.
4. Cardboard boxes are to be broken down & 1 tied in bundles (no more than 3'x 3' in size).

## **BULK WASTE PICK-UP**

**HOUSEHOLD BULK WASTE** SUCH AS FURNITURE, SHELVING, GRILLS (No propane tanks.) LADDERS, APPLIANCES AND LARGE FIXTURES WILL BE PICKED-UP FROM CURB ON THE **4<sup>TH</sup> THURSDAY OR FRIDAY OF THE MONTH.** (See page 1 to determine the day for your section.) APPLIANCES THAT CONTAIN FREON MUST HAVE FREON REMOVED BY A CERTIFIED FREON REMOVAL CONTRACTOR\* AND TAGGED BEFORE PLACING ON THE CURB. FOR SAFETY PURPOSES, PLEASE REMOVE REFRIGERATOR DOORS! **ELECTRONICS WILL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THIS PICK-UP**

**ELECTRONICS BULK WASTE** SUCH AS COMPUTERS, COMPUTER MICE, MONITORS, CABLES, PRINTERS, STEREOs, VCR/DVD PLAYERS, TV'S SMALLER THAN 32 INCHES, TELEPHONES, CAMERAS, RADIOS, SCANNERS, GAME PLAYERS, COPY & FAX MACHINES, CELL PHONES, ANSWERING MACHINES, TAPE RECORDERS, TOASTERS, MICROWAVES, ETC. ARE TO BE PLACED ON THE CURB FOR PICK-UP ON THE **4<sup>TH</sup> MONDAY IN JUNE (ANNUALLY)** BY THE BOROUGH PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT FOR RECYCLING. **Place items at curbside the night before pick-up day. Items put out after the crew completes pick-up will not be collected. If you miss the pick-up, you can take computer equipment, only, to the Ocean County Northern Recycling Center. No fee required.**

### **HOLIDAYS**

No pick-ups will be made on the following holidays: New Years Day, Martin Luther King, President's Day, Memorial Day, 4<sup>th</sup> of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving & Christmas Day. The pick-up for those days will be the following calendar day except Sundays.

## **A. RECYCLABLE PICK-UP – BACK DOOR**

### **Wednesday - Townwide (Bottles and Cans)**

**NO MORE THAN TWO (2) CONTAINERS** picked up at your back door. Recyclables are co-mingled in 50 gal. capacity or less refuse cans. (No cardboard boxes, bags of any type, laundry baskets, buckets, etc.) **All excess recyclable containers are to be placed at curbside.** Recycling stickers are available at Borough Hall for identification of recycling containers.

1. Tin and aluminum cans. (No foil wrap!)
2. Glass bottles, jars and other glass containers.
3. Empty household NON-HAZARDOUS aerosol spray cans (cooking sprays, deodorizers, glass and bathroom cleaners, hairsprays and antiperspirant sprays).
4. Plastic containers from bath, kitchen or laundry. (Where the neck is smaller than the rest of the container)
5. Plastic beverage containers. (No juice cartons, waxed cartons, drink boxes or food containers (i.e. yogurt, margarine, sour cream, frozen dinner trays) – they are household trash – not recyclable!)

**NOTE: No Styrofoam of any form or pellets in any recycling container (this is household trash). NO HAZARDOUS waste in aerosol cans or other hazardous waste in any recycling container. (HAZARDOUS WASTE, see \* description on page 4.)**

**B. RECYCLABLE PICK-UP – CURBSIDE**

**Wednesday - Townwide (Paper Recycling)**

Mantoloking residents have **TWO OPTIONS** for their curbside Paper Recycling!

**ALL IN ONE BIN PAPER RECYCLING**

**OPTION # 1**

Take all items and place them all together, loose, in one container no more than 50 gal. capacity and no more than 50 lbs. per container. **Do not use plastic bags.** Cover the container with a lid, place curbside.

You may put in your container, junk mail, newspapers with inserts, magazines, computer paper, office papers, empty brown paper bags and shredded paper.

Cardboard boxes are to be broken down, tied in bundles (no more than 3' x 3' in size) and placed at curbside on the trash days for your section.

**Excluded items:**

Items that are excluded are any food, cereal and pizza boxes, plastic bags, and paper plates. These items are household trash & garbage. Telephone books are to be recycled separately and brought to the container in front of the firehouse.

Please remember to remove your empty container from curbside at the end of the day.  
(So it does not blow away!)

**OPTION # 2**

Continue to bundle and tie all newspapers, magazines and catalogs and place at curbside on Tuesday night for Wednesday pickup. **Note:** Please do not put paper recyclable items out any earlier than the night before. Wet or soiled paper is considered trash and garbage.

**NEWSPAPER \* MAGAZINES \* JUNK MAIL \* WRITING/COPY PAPER**

Bundled & tied. Do not put into bags or containers of any type.

Our contract haulers will accommodate your two options every Wednesday which is our  
**TOWNWIDE RECYCLABLE PICK-UP DAY!**

## **OTHER MANDATORY RECYCLABLE MATERIALS IN OCEAN COUNTY THAT WILL NOT BE PICKED-UP BY BOROUGH TRASH COMPANY!**

***THESE ITEMS MUST BE DISPOSED OF BY OCCUPANT OR PRIVATE HAULER. (See list of private haulers below.)***

**AUTOMOTIVE PARTS** – Disposal is sole responsibility of owner. (Auto Batteries, Auto Motor Oil, etc)  
**DRY CELL BATTERIES** – Drop-off container is located in lobby of Borough Hall. Dry cell (alkaline) batteries are those used in flashlights, toys, portable radios, hearing aids, etc.

**TIRES** – Regular passenger car tires without rims can be taken to the Ocean County Remanufacturing Center, Route 9, Toms River. Fee: \$2 per tire up to 10 tires. Fee: Over 10 tires- \$120. per ton. Call 732-244-1716 for directions.

**\*HAZARDOUS WASTE (Among others)** – Paints/thinners, solvents, pool chemicals, pesticides, herbicides, aerosol cans, chemical auto products, toilet and drain cleaners, silver and brass polishes, various household cleaners, oil, gasoline, lead acid batteries and fluorescent bulbs. The OCNRC conducts a “Hazardous Waste Disposal Program” twice per year; once in the Spring and once in the Fall. The locations and dates for this program are advertised in advance. By Law, the Borough may not dispose of hazardous waste. No fee required.

**STEEL PAINT CANS** – Full, partially full and empty paint cans are accepted every day except Sundays at Pt. Pleasant Beach Recycle and OCNCR for Ocean County residents and taxpayers ONLY. Hours are 8:00am to 3:00pm and the limit is 20 paint cans per day. No fee required.

### **DIRECTIONS TO THE OCEAN COUNTY NORTHERN RECYCLING CENTER (OCNRC)**

Take Route 528 West, which becomes Cedar Bridge Road, to New Hampshire Avenue, and turn left. The OCNRC is one and one-half blocks on the left. The telephone number is 732-367-0802, and the hours are Monday through Saturday, 7:30 AM to 3:00 PM.
