**MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING
March 28, 2013**

A Special Meeting of the Mayor and Council was held this day in the meeting room of the Mantoloking Fire House with the following results.

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Nebel opened the meeting at 4:30 p.m.

OPEN PUBLIC MEETING STATEMENT: Mayor Nebel

In compliance with the provisions of the New Jersey Open Public Meetings Act, adequate notice of this meeting of the Mantoloking Borough Council has been advertised in the manner provided by law.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE The Mayor led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance.

MAYOR AND COUNCIL COMMENT

Mayor Nebel announced that the award of contract for the demolition of private homes is postponed until Governor Christie sends additional information on asbestos waste. He stated that the Council is hopeful that we will not have to rebid the project. Therefore, the resolution authorizing a third Special Emergency Appropriation is postponed till we know what our contract award amount is.

PUBLIC COMMENTS PERIOD

Three commentators questioned the amount of bids received on the demolition project; notification of neighbors when homes are being demolished by contractor; and, extension of waiver of permit fees for repairs.
