The regular monthly meeting of the Mayor and Council was called to order August 19, 2013 at 5:30 PM by Mayor George Nebel.

All present

The agenda for the regular business and special meetings will be made available in advance of the meeting on the Borough website.

Minutes of the 3 previous Regular /Special meeting was approved.

***Special Presentation - Regina Foley - Chief nurse and Executive Vice President /Operations Ocean Medical Center Emergency Room***

***The \$82 million dollar project to overhaul the emergency department has been completed. It is a state of the art facility !! It is strongly recommended that everyone visit for a tour. New facility is 44,000 sq ft. There are specialty services including pediatric and express care.***

**Privilege of the Floor**

PVS spent time at the ocean Medical Center - beautiful center with outstanding nursing care

VM - comment on appointment of April Yezzi to position of CFO - concern that she was released from her previous position in Bay Head. SG commented that there is no evidence other than anecdotal that this is true.

JL - were there options for this position other than full time yes - Bay Head chose to outsource . Manto has not chosen the same path. Is there a probation period - no - controlled by statute

PF - present for grand opening of Ocean Medical Emergency center - was overwhelmed by the scope of service etc

**Councilman Gillingham**, Finance Committee , moved to accept the report of the Municipal Finance Officer, Michele Swisher as of June 30, 2014 . Expenditures year to date total \$4,768,136.81,encumbered \$130,599.46 for a balance of \$2,656,665.69 vs budget of \$7,555,401.96

Additional resolutions were passed: (1)payment of bills \$536,391.76 for August,(2) appointment of April Yezzi to the position of CFO effective Sept 2, 2014 at a salary of \$75,000

Regular meetings will take place at MYC 5:30 PM Sept 16, Oct 21, Nov 25 and Dec 16

**Councilman Mc Intyre**, Public Safety Committee - moved resolutions (1) designation of 6 official personnel - Special Officers to be activated on an as needed basis (2) 2 applications for membership in the MFC - Mario Fini and Louis Carlucci .

Councilman Brown questioned what is being done regarding large expenditures anticipated by the MFC for equipment - especially for breathing apparatus.... looking for grants - we must be compliant !

**Fire Chief Larry Gilman** - Thank you for your donations!

During the month of July, MFC responded to 19 fire calls, held 1 training drill and our regularly scheduled business meeting. Calls included fire alarms, gas leaks and odor investigations, mulch fire and distressed swimmer

***OEM Coordinator Robert McIntyre - submitted by Sergeant Stacy Ferris*** - OEM continues to be busy working on the recovery and restoration of the Borough of Mantoloking. Daily activities include coordinating and directing the planning, organization and control of the Federal Disaster DR4086. To date, we have 16 open projects, 13 large, 3 small and have submitted for closeout on 7 of them.

To date, the Borough has received \$4,554,088.67 of the \$7,278,890.40 submitted. To date, FEMA has obligated \$7,945,272.35. We are projecting total submitted to reach close to \$10,000,000. We have an additional \$78,883.29 batching for payment to the Boro by month end.

Steel Sheet: anticipating arrival of second machine authorization given to allow for Saturday work as needed. The average advancement is anticipated to be 140-200 feet per day...expected to reach Lyman first week in September.

There are at least 42 other offenders in town It seems unpatriotic to be removing flags and poles just because there are no longer structures present on the properties.***

***Can we engage any of our Federal contacts to assist?***

***Councilwoman Nelson - no idea at this time***

***PF - concern about Rt 35 right of way issues - where are they? 10 feet from where pavement ends***

***The corner of Barnegat and Herbert is very narrow and many people hitting curb when making right turn onto Herbert***

***JL - what is status of Rogers Group - have they been hired? no***

***We have 3 candidates with tenure ranging 8-22 years - all are known - are we still hiring interim Civilian Public Safety Director?***

***Contract with Rogers not finalized...once done progress will be quick***

***PS - seems like we are dragging our feet on the appointment of a new Chief of Police- there is precedent in Manto for skipping the chain of command in the appointment of a new Chief- don't think we need a consultant - we do need a new Chief now!***

***PF - we need to get Verizon back to Manto, Apparently FCC has not approved their withdrawal...need to be more proactive in bringing them back***

***JC - Mayor and Council have done a wonderful job post Sandy. We need to give them our confidence and allow them to make the critical decisions for the Boro and stop picking them apart!!!***

Many residents have complained about sediment or brown color in their water. Installing a filter might help. Check also with New Jersey American Water .
