REVIEW OF AGENDA ITEMS Regular Council Meeting of Tuesday, October 21, 2014

MAYOR AND COUNCIL COMMENT

Councilman McIntyre spoke about parking spaces between Herbert and Lyman St. and the extending parking hours from 2 hours to 4 hours. He also mentioned that FEMA would like us to look at a long term plan as to how we can reduce flooding risks.

Mayor Nebel stated that letters will be sent to homeowners whose properties have shown no activity since the storm. The DEP Commissioner will be here Tuesday at 11:00 for completion of Steel Revetment.

Councilwoman Nelson gave an update on the new Borough Hall: 1) waiting for final plans from architect, 2) hoping to go out to bid in January, 3) break ground in mid- March, 4) construction will take about a year and it was also stated we have flooding in 3 specific areas and we are trying to take some action to get them under control.

PUBLIC COMMENTS PERIOD

There were five comments from the audience with regards to safety issues:

Equipment being parked between Barnegat Lane and Ocean Ave.

Traffic light at Lyman causing motorist confusion as to the right of way

People driving the wrong way on East Avenue

It was asked if snow fencing could be installed by the last two properties on East Avenue by the rocks to stop people and children from accessing and walking across this dangerous area.
