

- The first class will be for basic construction
- The second class will involve smoothing the piece, putting on appliqués or handles and overall perfecting.
- The third class will be glazing the pottery.

## Watercolor Wonders

### Course Description:

Relaxed Atmosphere...Individual Attention...Fun with watercolor!

Workshop 1: create natural looking crashing waves full of energy and movement!

Workshop 2: paint a colorful autumn tree using mostly big brushes!

Workshop 3: paint light and airy fog using a wet-in-wet technique!

In each lesson, parents and students will explore the medium of watercolor paints. They will observe basic watercolor painting techniques such as wet-on-wet, wet-on-dry and dry-on-dry. As a class, we will work together experimenting with these techniques on small squares of watercolor paper. A demonstration for the night's lesson will be broken down into easy steps to follow. A finished matted work will be created in the 1 ½ hour.

Materials for this workshop include Watercolor paper, brushes, watercolor paints.

## Spend a few evenings exploring the ILIAD by Homer

Class I: Class will review the ILIAD by Homer with the teacher, watch a film clip of Troy and then go over their assignment. In pairs, the class, with student aid, will develop a PowerPoint based on the character in the Iliad. The two major components of the assignment:

1. Identify the importance/role of the character in Greek Mythology/History
2. Identify the importance/role of the character in the Trojan War

There will be 15 Character/Gods/Goddesses that will be assigned, one to each group.

Class II: The class will research and develop one slide for each component of the assignment using the Macs with student aid.

Class III: The class will present their PowerPoints and be "graded" by the teacher.

## Woods – The Cutting Edge Maximum class size: **10 Students**

### Course Description:

Spend time becoming familiar with the use of a biscuit joiner, router and other tools as you make a cutting board.

- Be given precut maple strips
- See a demo on how to use a biscuit joiner
- See a demo on cutting board glue up prior to their gluing their own
- See a demo on surface planing
- Students will cut their board to finish size/shape
- Students will apply an edge with a router
- Wood surface will be prepared for finishing
- Finish will be applied to the completed project
