- Chairman Bixby called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.
- The minutes of the March meeting were approved.

- C. Bixby stated that he has had some preliminary discussions with the Planning Board chairman regarding information coordination. The MEC will insure that information distributed by the Commission will convey the same message as other Borough agencies.
- E. McIntyre stated that the NJ Green Building Council was sponsoring a presentation on April 18, 2013 at Sacred Heart Church in Bay Head. A few of the commission members plan to attend.
- C. Bixby suggested that the Commission submit a report to Mayor and Council reporting on the Commission's recent activities and future plans. After some discussion it was agreed that a report should be submitted. C. Bixby to provide.
- The members discussed the MEC's next activity, such as sponsoring a presentation on landscaping and gardening post Sandy or running an "adopt-a-spot" like event on one of the bay side public areas. These plans will be discussed further at the May meeting.
- B. Nelson led a detailed discussion of the NJ DOT's stormwater management plan for the resurfaced Rt. 35. At the end of the discussion it was the sense of the Commission that the pumping stations and the associated piping systems planned for Lyman Street and Downer Avenue are not well thought out and the Commission would provide comments or input if requested by Mayor and Council.
