



# MANTOLOKING 2011 CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION

## Schedule, Helpful Hints, & Answers to Frequently Asked Questions

---

- All events are rain or shine - including the July 1, 9 PM fireworks over Barnegat Bay. Only in case of high winds will the fireworks be postponed to Saturday July 2.
- Please be certain to always bring your tickets with you, as this will be the only way to gain access to the events.
- There will be a tremendous number of people in Mantoloking for this event to celebrate our history and our pride in our community. Please show that pride by not dropping trash on the ground and helping to pick up/straighten if others are not as considerate.
- Parking will be at a premium throughout Mantoloking during the Centennial Celebration. Please walk or ride a bike if possible, or carpool when driving. There will be a bike corral at the west end of Downer Avenue for bike parking – please remember to LOCK your bike as this area will be unattended.
- There will be NO PARKING at MYC from Monday June 27 through Monday July 4<sup>th</sup>. The west end of Downer Avenue will be closed to automobiles the evening of July 1 to make room for firework spectators. The entire length of Bay Avenue will be available for parking on both sides of the street, as well as the lot at St Simon-by-the-Sea during the events on July 1 and 3.

### **Thursday July 30**

- Patriotic Flower Show & Garden Education Day presented by the Seaweeders Garden Club of Bay Head & Mantoloking. 1- 6 PM, admission is free but donations will be gratefully accepted.

### **Friday July 1**

---

- A clam bake will be held at the Mantoloking Yacht Club (MYC) from 6-9 PM. Bring your ticket with you.
- The MYC grounds will open at 9 PM, after the clam bake, for non-ticket holders wishing to view the fireworks.
- Lifejackets are required to be worn by all children eight years of age and younger whenever they are on or near the docks at MYC.
- Remember to bring a beach chair to view the fireworks from the MYC lawn.
- Mantoloking Moonshine, the remastered movie, will be shown on MYC lawn following the fireworks. DVDs of the movie will be available for sale - \$15 (cash or checks made out to Robert Post).

### Sunday July 3

- Sunrise Church Service at 7 AM on the beach at Downer Ave. Please bring a beach chair. In the event of rain, the service will be held at St. Simon-by-the-Sea.
- Pancake Breakfast at the firehouse at 8 AM. Tickets will be sold at the door.
- Dessert Bake-off – please drop off entries between 2:00 and 2:30 PM at the tent at MYC. Awards will be presented on Monday following the July 4<sup>th</sup> parade.
- The Centennial Dance– 7:30-11:30 PM at MYC. The dance does NOT include dinner. Please BYOB, set ups will be provided. Bake-off entries and other desserts will be served at the dance. Bring your ticket with you.
- Awards for the bake-off will be announced at the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Ceremony following the parade.


