

Dear Beach Front Property Owner,

The unparalleled devastation sustained by the entire Borough as a result of Super Storm Sandy was principally a result of storm waves overtopping the Borough's dune system. In those barrier island communities where the U.S. Army Corps dune and beach restoration had been completed, storm damage was relatively nominal. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will provide the renourishment. It remains the sole responsibility of the Borough to obtain the required Easement before the project can be approved for construction.

At present, the Borough is considering the implementation of a system which incorporates both stone armor and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers designed dune and beach. It appears that this dual technique will offer the highest probability for successful defense against major storms.

Accompanying this letter is a copy of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers form of the required Easement. The document may, also, be downloaded from the Borough's website at www.mantoloking.org. Your prompt completion, execution and return of this document to Borough of Mantoloking, P.O. Box 4391, Brick, New Jersey 08723 will facilitate advancing our effort to restore and preserve the community. Your signature must be acknowledged by a notary public or New Jersey Attorney. I would like all easements in hand before Christmas.
