MY COMPANY HAS PERFORMED THE FOLLOWING

Gas piping in the residential structure has been totally or partially submerged and was blown out and pressure tested with a pressure of not less than 3 psi for a period of 10 minutes and is in safe working condition.

OR

Gas piping has not been submerged, but, the appliance has been partially or completely submerged, the existing gas pipe joints were tested to determine if leaks exist and none were found/or repairs were made. (This can be accomplished by any acceptable method including but not limited to a "soap-test").

Gas-fired or oil-fired appliances that have been partially or completely submerged will be replaced and appropriate permit applications will be filed.

OR

Manufacturer's instructions for repairs have been followed and the furnace/ water heater or boiler is/are in safe working condition

OR

I have inspected the gas lines and found they were not under water and are in safe working condition.

And

The gas piping system is in safe working order and gas service may be initiated to the residence.

Must submit tag from NJNG signed by homeowner and contractor with contractor contact info.
