We have been working diligently to resume Retail operations in Mantoloking to alleviate the current process of visiting the Brick post office to retrieve mail.

The Mantoloking post office is scheduled to reopen by late March, once all repairs have been completed. Delivery has resumed to the residents who are currently in their homes. We anticipate that the number of residents returning to their homes will increase going forward.
