Borough of Mantoloking Re-population Rules

Effective immediately, Rt. 35 (Ocean Ave.) & Rt. 528 (Herbert St.) will be open to the general public 24 hours a day. Please review the below listed guidelines for residents who are seeking to re-populate their homes;

1. **No Parking** on any street.
2. All residents and contractors working in Mantoloking must have their pass with them at all times. **(No Exceptions)**
3. Hours of operation for contractors working in town will be 7 AM to 6 PM Monday through Saturday. No contracted work on Sundays.
4. The Borough has enacted a gated community concept that will allow access to secondary streets to residents, contractors and **authorized personnel only**
5. We ask that all residents and contractors stay on their private property, to limit the amount of traffic on the already congested side streets. From 9 PM to 6 AM there will be a pedestrian curfew in effect on all Borough streets. The beach remains closed to all persons 24 hours a day.
6. All Persons and vehicles are subject to random security checks to ensure compliance of the rules and to prevent looting and other violations.
7. Bay Ave from Arnold to Downer will be a two way street until further notice. From Princeton to Arnold, Bay Avenue will be one-way, northbound.
8. All Borough Ordinances, State and local laws still apply and will be enforced, including having operational smoke and carbon monoxide detectors.
9. Containers, Dumpsters and items placed on property must be within setbacks and have proper Zoning Permits.
10. Please note there will be **no** household trash pickup! All household trash / garbage needs to be taken to the dumpsters sites at Rt. 35 and Princeton and or at the corner of Barnegat Lane & Lyman Ave by the home owner. The recycling dumpster is located in front of the old Police Station. The dumpsters cannot be used for Construction Debris.
11. As repopulation of Mantoloking begins, please be aware that all homes previously posted or red tagged are considered UNSAFE until adequate corrective measures are taken. Each home with any amount of structural damage or safety concerns will be issued a "Notice of Unsafe Structure" or "Notice of Unsafe condition". This is to advise the owner of the need to make repairs, even if minor in nature. All residents and visitors should use extreme caution around these and all structures and debris to avoid injury.

Unsafe Structures must follow requirements to have permits and inspections to verify corrective measures, and may require a NJ Design Professional evaluation to determine mitigation measures.

There may be some homes considered Not Habitable as they are potentially unsafe for occupancy. These concerns will be noted on the Unsafe Structure Notice when issued.
