- Chairman Bixby called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.
- The minutes of the August 2015 meeting were approved.

- As a member of the Seaweeders Garden Club, C. Bixby asked Joan if she had any new information on the Patty Brand Garden. Joan stated that Phase I has been completed and that Phase II should be underway in the near future.
- The Rt. 35 storm water collection system was brought up for discussion. No one had any new information regarding the infiltration of ground water into the system.

After some discussion it was decided to try find a speaker for the topic of landscaping with native plants. J. Mattia volunteered to contact some folks to see who would be willing to speak on this topic.
- Ms. Mattia stated that the Seaweeders continue to maintain the flower boxes near the Public Works parking lot and next to the fire house. The flower boxes outside of the temporary police department headquarters are maintained by the Chief of Police.
