Protective Sheet Piling - Revetment

- Contractor is projected to complete 150' to 250' a day per crew.
- Work areas will be fenced off for safety 500' at a time, where there will be no access.
- Please stay clear of construction & the steel that will be staged on the top of the dune

FEMA Reimbursement

- To date the Borough has spent \$5,948,316.68 million dollars out of the 7.1 million dollar emergency fund.
- FEMA has obligated \$8,471,908.39 (made available) to us.
- The Borough of Mantoloking has received \$4,717,117.15 in reimbursement to date.
- We are projecting The Borough will receive between 9 – 12 million dollars once all projects are complete.
- Rent for Borough Hall, Police, storage units, badge trailer & porta potties is currently approved through April of 2016

FEMA Reimbursement

- Funding is 90 / 10 split FEMA / Boro
- 17 total projects 14 large 3 small
- 7 projects have been submitted for closeout & final payment

- Temporary pump station \$362,295.50 / 36,229.05
- Pump Station replacement \$1,187,769.10 / 118,776.91
- Town wide roads, curbs & sidewalks \$697,856.00 / 6,978.56
- Temporary Facilities \$ 375,000 / 37,500
- Emergency Protective measures \$2,500,000 / 250,000
- Borough hall / PD – currently being rewritten for additional funds.
- Donated resources \$135,000 credited towards our 10%
