### **ORDINANCE NO. 641**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF  
MANTOLOKING, OCEAN COUNTY, NEW JERSEY, AMENDING  
THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE  
BOROUGH OF MANTOLOKING, 2007,  
ARTICLE IV, SECTION 2-22, POLICE**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mantoloking, Ocean County, New Jersey, as follows;

1. Sub-article 2-22 is amended by addition of Sub-Article 2-22.3.5 – Police

Director: [NEW]

- (a) The Borough may, upon nomination by the Mayor and approval of Council, appoint a civilian Police Director who shall serve at the pleasure of the Council and shall be compensated in accordance with the terms set forth in a mutually agreed Employment Contract;
- (b) The Director shall, in the absence of the appointment of a Chief of Police or a vacancy in such office, have and exercise all authority of the Department, except for law enforcement which shall be the responsibility of Members of the Department;
- (c) The Director shall be responsible to the Borough Council for the efficiency and routine day-to-day operations of the Department, including, but not limited to administration and enforcement of the Rules and Regulations of the Department, the purpose, functions and priorities of the Department, establish and implementation of all schedules and assignments of all personnel;
- (d) The Director shall execute and/or implement all policies and directives issued by the Borough Council as the Appropriate Authority;
- (e) The Director shall have and shall exercise all of the powers, authority and responsibilities of a Chief of Police, except those which, as a matter of law (law enforcement), are reserved to a Member of the Police Department.

2. The Ordinance to which this Ordinance is an amendment and all Rules

and Regulations and amendments thereof are hereby ratified, confirmed and re-adopted.

3. In the event that any portion of this amendatory Ordinance shall be adjudicated to be illegal or unenforceable, all of the remainder of this and of the Ordinance to which this is an amendment shall remain in full force and effect.

4. This Ordinance shall be effective upon final adoption.
