HOUSEHOLD TRASH PICK-UP

**2 PICK-UPS PER WEEK ON MONDAY AND THURSDAY-
CURBSIDE EFFECTIVE JUNE 23-SEPT 29**

Independent contractors, builders, landscapers and painters must dispose of their own trash. No dock lumber, bulkhead lumber, or decking will be accepted.

PICKUP ALLOWS THREE (3) CONTAINERS of household trash per pick-up day. All containers are to be no more than 50 gal. capacity and weigh no more than 50 lbs.

ADDITIONAL CURBSIDE PICK-UP ITEMS (YARD WASTE)

PICKUP ALLOWS THREE (3) CONTAINERS OF YARD WASTE PER PICK-UP DAY (IN ADDITION TO YOUR (3) CONTAINERS OF HOUSEHOLD TRASH)

The following items will be collected on the **collection days of your trash schedule**, and they **must be placed at the curb**.

1. Bagged or tied clippings, grass, leaves, small branches, and yard trash. Bundles must be less than 4 feet in length and weigh less than 40 lbs. *
2. Large cardboard boxes – break down & tie in bundles (no more than 3'x 3' in size).

RECYCLING

1 PICK-UP PER WEEK ON WEDNESDAY - CURBSIDE

NO MORE THAN TWO (2) CONTAINERS picked up at curb. Recyclables are co-mingled in 50 gal. capacity or less, can and weigh no more than 50 pounds. (No plastics bags of any type, laundry baskets, buckets, etc.) **All excess recyclables are to be placed in a container(s)**

at curbside. Heavy Items such as tied stacks of Magazines and Newspaper must be placed at curbside.

Important Points

- Recycling cans must be dry and covered with a lid.
- No need to remove tape, paper clips, staples, stamps, labels, metal fasteners, rubber bands.
- Empty and rinse all cans and bottles.
- Do not tie newspapers, magazines or cardboard if in a container. **(Weigh less than 50 lbs!)**
- **Do not use any kind of plastic bags as containers or as a recyclable item.**
- No hazardous trash in any recycling can. (See Hazardous Trash on page 4)

Accepted Recyclables

Newspapers/Magazines
Small corrugated boxes
Mixed Papers / Junk Mail
Aluminum, steel and tin cans
Plastic bottles (neck smaller than body)
Glass bottles and jars
Catalogs / paper bags / gift-wrap
Empty aerosol cans (non chemical)
Phone books / paperback books
Shredded paper in a paper bag
Office paper / file folders
Paper board boxes (cereal, pasta)
Photo, wrapping or tissue paper

Not Accepted Recyclables

(Put in Trash)

Aluminum foil, paper towels & napkins
Pizza Boxes
Waxed paper / waxed cardboard
Food containers (frozen deli food)
Paper milk or juice containers
Plastic bags of any kind
Styrofoam of any kind
Wire / wire or plastic hangers
Paper or plastic plates
Light bulbs
Holiday light strings
Ceramics, china, drinking glasses or cookware
Mirrors, window or auto glass

MANDATORY RECYCLABLE MATERIALS IN OCEAN COUNTY THAT WILL NOT BE PICKED-UP BY BOROUGH TRASH COMPANY!

THESE ITEMS MUST BE DISPOSED OF BY OCCUPANT OR A PRIVATE HAULER

AUTOMOTIVE PARTS – Disposal is sole responsibility of owner. (Auto Batteries, Auto Motor Oil, etc.)

STEEL PAINT CANS – Full, partially full and empty paint cans are accepted every day except Sundays at Pt. Pleasant Beach Recycle and OCNRC for Ocean County residents and taxpayers ONLY. Hours are 8:00am to 3:00pm and the limit is 20 paint cans per day. No fee required.

TIRES- The County is accepting tires without rims at both of the County's Recycling Centers; Monday - Saturday 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Proof of residency or tax bill must be provided. The program accepts up to 5 tires per day at a fee of \$2.00 per tire. The Centers accept tires that are no larger than a truck tire and no smaller than a 13 inch tire. Bicycle, Motorcycle or racing car tires are NOT accepted.

COMPUTERS & PERIPHERALS will be accepted at the Ocean County Northern Recycling Center.

***DIRECTIONS TO THE OCEAN COUNTY NORTHERN RECYCLING CENTER (OCNRC)**

Take Route 528 West, which becomes Cedar Bridge Road, to New Hampshire Avenue, and turn left. The OCNRC is one and one-half blocks on the left. The telephone number is 732-367-0802, and the hours are Monday through Saturday, 7:30 AM to 3:00 PM. www.oceannj.us/solidwaste
