With 2.2 miles of beach, there is plenty of room for many activities.

If you plan to stay for more than two hours, remember ...

There are no restrooms, places to eat, or shady areas, and on-street parking is limited.



The recreational use of Mantoloking's 2.2 miles of beach will be complicated this summer by the installation of a sheet metal revetment, local dune restoration efforts that accompany it, the State Department of Transportation's improvements to Route 35, and possibly the initiation of the Corps of Engineers long awaited beach and dune replenishment.



Mantoloking's Office of Emergency Management (OEM), the Mantoloking Police Department (MPD) and the Department of Public Works (DPW) are committed to helping residents and visitors enjoy the beach while minimizing the risks associated with sharing the borough with so many unrelated activities.

This brochure contains information about the locations and conditions of available beach access points. Please be especially aware of the distances you must walk, possibility of foreign objects in the sand, lack of facilities, and other unanticipated inconveniences.
