Please accept the following as the monthly report for the Mantoloking Police Department and Emergency Management both of which continue to be busy through the summer months;

**Special Announcement:** We are excited to announce an addition to our Mantoloking Family our Administrative Assistant Kelly had a healthy baby boy on 9/3/2015. She will be out on leave till December so filling in for her will be two of our SLEO I Sean and Logan. The desk will be maned Monday thru Friday from 9-3PM.

### **Dispatch:**

- We logged 307 report entries
- 215 summons were issued
- 13 Borough Ord. Violations
- 11 arrests for DWI & Warrants
- 52 building checks were done on Sandy damaged homes

### **Directed Patrols Ongoing:**

- Construction starting before 8 AM – Contractors were called and issued copies of the Borough Ord.
- Trespassing on Private Property – we are encouraging residents to place no trespassing signs on empty lots to alert visitors to the area that these are not parking lots.
- Drinking on the beach – we have received complaints reference residents, renters and visitors drinking on the beach. Officers are out enforcing the Ordinance!
- Dogs on the beach without leashes before 8 AM and after 6 PM. Please remember during our summer months dogs are not permitted on the beach from 8 – 6 PM. We have received several complaints from residents so we have been handing out copies of the ord. to dog owners prior to issuing any summons.
- Stopping for pedestrians in crosswalks
- Bike Helmets on all adolescents under 17 years old. Parents make **SURE** your kids have their helmets on before they leave the house, as you will be the one being ticketed.
- Speeding on Bay Ave. in the area of Old Bridge and the Yacht club

### **Special Alerts:**

- **KEEP OFF DUNE signs are still available at Borough Hall and the PD while supplies last.**
- **Please make sure traffic stops before entering into the lanes of travel when crossing the highway**
- **Phone Scams are on the rise; please use caution when doing business over the phone, if you are unsure, get a name and number and call your financial provider directly do not hand over information regarding credit cards and accounts unless you called your providers directly.**
- **All vacant property owners are encouraged to post “No Trespassing” signs.**

### **Financial Update:**

- **Deposited to Date: \$5,840,896.29**
- **Deposited in 2015: \$984,885.69**
- Myself and Chief Ferris have been meeting with a JLWitt representative working for the State on a weekly basis to audit and closeout all of our projects, and will continue to meet until Sandy is closed.
- **PPDR/Demo PW’s 3347/3348** - have been paid and closed out
- **PW 922** - Firehouse –is the next project that we will be presenting to the State for closeout review.
- **PW 1690** - Beach Crossovers & Walkways – there has been a Request for Reimbursement in the amount of \$36,532.06 - which we look to receive \$32,878.85 after our 10% share – this was for the work done by DPW to rebuild walkways for the summer
- **PW 203** - We have signed off on this projects closed out – this is one of our biggest projects at \$2.766million. We must wait for congressional review since our overage is over the \$1m threshold before being paid out.
- **PW 3863 – Roads, Curbs & Sidewalks** – as soon as the final payment is released to Bondex I will be able to submit for the Reimbursement Request – est \$45,000 after the 10% share

### **Projects:**

- **Rt. 35 Reconstruction Project** – We have been speaking with the NJDOT and they will be actively working in town over the next couple of months on a punch list that was provided by HMM engineer Larry Plevier, Fire & Police Chiefs, DPW, and construction officials. - **Permanent Pump Station FEMA PW #4791**- Work continues on the pump station and we hope to see the completion prior to the end of September.
  
- **Crossover & Walkways FEMA PW #1690** – The remainder of this project will be placed on hold pending the ACOE project.
  
- **Roads, Curbs & Sidewalks FEMA PW #3863** – HMM is currently preparing bid specs for the remaining curbs and sidewalks damaged by the storm and the paving of Barnegat Lane.
  
- **Beach Push** – DPW has been consistently out on the beach pushing sand to protect the dunes and keeping the steel wall covered. Since the last report they have completed two complete pushes. They will be pushing a small area around Williams in the next couple of months.
  
- **Beach Badge Trailer & Sales** – badge sales and checkers ended on Aug. 31. We will be scheduling an end of the beach season meeting with both associations before the end of September to discuss the seasons lessons learned and ideas for next year.
