The Committee and its sub-committees have been charged by the Mayor with a redesign of the Borough Hall with the goal of a lower cost, smaller footprint building that maintains the aesthetic value of our community (labeled Phase 1) plus the development of a long range strategic plan for the Borough (Phase 2).
