HOUSEHOLD TRASH PICK-UP - BACKDOOR

April 3rd through September 29th

2 Pick-ups per week on Mondays and Thursdays

October 1st through April 1st

1 Pick-up per week on Mondays

**PLEASE HAVE ALL TRASH AND RECYCLABLES OUT FOR
COLLECTION PRIOR TO 6:00 AM.**

**Independent contractors, builders, landscapers and painters must dispose of their own
trash.**

No dock lumber, bulkhead lumber or decking will be accepted.

**PICKUP ALLOWS THREE (3) CONTAINERS of household trash per pick-up day. All
containers are to be no larger than 50 gal. Capacity and weigh no more than 50 lbs. each.**

Any eligible waste in excess of three (3) containers shall be placed at the curb.

YARD WASTE - CURBSIDE

The following items will be collected on the **collection days of your trash schedule**. Pick up allows three (3) containers, bags, or bundles of yard waste/garbage per pick up day. Material in excess of 3 containers **MUST** be placed at the curb.

Yard waste may be in a container, bagged or tied in bundles and may include the following: clippings, grass, leaves, small branches, and yard trash. Bundles must be less than 4 feet in length and weigh less than 40 lbs. Please refrain from disposing of dirt with your yard waste.

RECYCLING PICK-UP - BACKDOOR

1 Pick-Up per week on Wednesdays year round

NO MORE THAN THREE (3) CONTAINERS picked up at your back door per pick up day. Recyclables are co-mingled in 50 gallon capacity or less containers and cannot weigh more than 50 pounds. (No plastics bags of any type, laundry baskets, buckets, etc.) **All excess recyclables are to be placed in a container(s) at curbside.** Heavy Items such as tied stacks of Magazines and Newspaper must be placed at curbside. Large cardboard boxes – break down & tie in bundles (no more than 3'x 3' in size).

Important Points

- Recycling cans must be dry and covered with a lid.
- No need to remove tape, paper clips, staples, stamps, labels, metal fasteners, rubber bands.
- Empty and rinse all cans and bottles.
- Do not tie newspapers, magazines or cardboard if in a container. **(Container must weigh less than 50 lbs.)**
- **Do not use any kind of plastic bags as containers or as a recyclable item.**
- No hazardous trash in any recycling can. (See Hazardous Trash on page 3)

Plastic bottles (neck smaller than body)

Office paper/file folders
Paper board boxes (cereal, pasta)
Photo, wrapping or tissue paper

Not Accepted Recyclables (Put in Trash)

Pizza Boxes
Waxed paper / waxed cardboard
Food containers (frozen deli food)
Paper milk or juice containers
Plastic bags of any kind
Styrofoam of any kind
Wire / wire or plastic hangers
Paper or plastic plates
Light bulbs
Holiday light strings
Ceramics, china, drinking glasses or cookware
Mirrors, window or auto glass
Shredded paper

MANDATORY RECYCLABLE MATERIALS IN OCEAN COUNTY THAT WILL NOT BE PICKED-UP BY BOROUGH TRASH COMPANY!

THESE ITEMS MUST BE DISPOSED OF BY OCCUPANT OR A PRIVATE HAULER

AUTOMOTIVE PARTS – Disposal is sole responsibility of owner. (Auto Batteries, Auto Motor Oil, etc.)

TIRES – Regular passenger car tires without rims can be taken to Remanufacturing Center, Route 9, Toms River. Fee: \$2 per tire up to 10 tires. Fee: Over 10 tires-\$120 per ton. Call 732-244-1716 for directions.

HAZARDOUS TRASH (Among others) – By Law the borough may not dispose of hazardous trash such as: Paints/thinners, solvents, pool chemicals, pesticides, herbicides, fertilizers, aerosol cans, chemical auto products, toilet and drain cleaners, silver and brass polishes, various household cleaners, oil, gasoline, lead acid batteries and fluorescent bulbs.

PAINT CANS – Full, partially full and empty paint cans are accepted every day except Sundays at Pt. Pleasant Beach Recycle and OCNCR for Ocean County residents and taxpayers ONLY. Hours are 8:00am to 3:00pm and the limit is 20 paint cans per day. No fee required.

ELECTRONIC BULK TRASH -Electronics may not be placed on the curb as trash or sent to a landfill. The Ocean County Northern Recycling Center (OCNRC) will accept Televisions, Computer Monitors, Central Processing Units, Laptops, Cell Phones, Laser and Inkjet cartridges.

DIRECTIONS TO THE OCEAN COUNTY NORTHERN RECYCLING CENTER (OCNRC)

Take Route 528 West, which becomes Cedar Bridge Road, to New Hampshire Avenue, and turn left. The OCNRC is one and one-half blocks on the left. The telephone number is 732-367-0802, and the hours are Monday through Saturday, 7:30 AM to 3:00 PM.

BULK TRASH PICK-UP - CURBSIDE

HOUSEHOLD BULK TRASH such as furniture, shelving, grills (no propane tanks), ladders, appliances and large fixtures will be picked up from the curb as follows:

April 3 rd through September 29:	4 th Thursday of the month
October 1 st through April 1 st :	4 th Monday of the month

Appliances that contain Freon must have the Freon removed by a certified Freon removal contractor and tagged before placing on the curb. Refrigerator doors must be removed. Automotive parts, tires, hazardous trash, paint cans and electronics are not included in this pick up.

HOLIDAYS

No pick-ups will be made on the following holidays: New Year's Day, Martin Luther King, President's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving & Christmas Day. The pick-up for those days will be the following calendar day except Sundays.

- The shredding unit features an automatic feeding and dumping system, eliminating human contact with your documents and forms.
- Each vehicle is limited to 6 boxes or bags of documents each day.
