6. PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE, Councilman White presented the monthly reports of the Police Department, Municipal Court, Fire Company, and Emergency Management and moved the following resolution.

Chief Ferris addressed the council regarding the need to hire an additional police officer due to the fact that we are down two officers. She announced it is her honor to recommend Logan LaRue as a full-time Police Officer. He will serve the Borough of Mantoloking in the standard which they deserve.

A. RESOLUTION NO. 12/18/2018-02: OF THE BOROUGH OF MANTOLOKING, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, APPOINTING LOGAN LA RUE AS A FULL TIME POLICE OFFICER

WHEREAS, the Borough of Mantoloking desires to hire a full-time Police Officer to serve within the Mantoloking Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police, Stacy Ferris, has recommended the appointment of Logan La Rue to the position of full-time Police Officer;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Mantoloking, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. At the recommendation of the Chief of Police ,Stacy Ferris, Logan LaRue is hereby appointed as a full-time Police Officer effective immediately at an annual salary of \$45,605.53.

Mayor Nebel, in gratitude for your hard work a sign will be put at Downer Avenue. Restore, Renew, Replenish. On behalf of the residents of Mantoloking we say thank you.

Mayor Nebel said this is very unexpected and thanked the Council and everybody. He was happy to spend the time needed and the town is better and stronger now.

Councilman Nelson presented Mayor Nebel with a new bike from the Nelson family.

Mayor Bill Curtis said on behalf of Bay Head, thank you for your years of service to the surrounding towns. You look way to happy.

A. RESOLUTION NO. 12/18/2018-04: OF THE BOROUGH OF MANTOLOKING, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, APPOINTING DONALD NESS TO THE SEAT ON THE BOROUGH COUNCIL LEFT VACANT BY THE RESIGNATION OF COUNCILWOMAN LYNN O’MEALIA

WHEREAS, Lynn O’Mealia was elected as Councilwoman for the Borough of Mantoloking in the General Election held on November 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS Lynn O’Mealia resigned from the position of Councilwoman for the Borough of Mantoloking, effective December 3, 2018, leaving a vacant seat on Borough Council; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:16-5 establishes that when a vacancy occurs on the governing body of a municipality, the governing body may, by a majority vote of the remaining members of the governing body, fill the vacancy temporarily by appointment until the next general election; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:16-11, the appropriate partisan organization has submitted three names for consideration by the governing body for appointment to the vacant seat on the Borough Council; and

WHEREAS, after review of the three nominees submitted, the Borough Council believes that it is in the best interests of the Borough of Mantoloking to select Donald Ness as the individual to fill the vacant governing body seat for the unexpired term in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:16-5(a).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Borough of Mantoloking, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. That Donald Ness is hereby appointed to the vacant seat on Borough Council pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:16-1 et seq.
2. That Donald Ness shall hold office for the unexpired term of Lynn O’Mealia expiring December 31, 2019 pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:16-5(a).

B. RESOLUTION NO. 12/18/2018-05 OF THE BOROUGH OF MANTOLOKING, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF MUNICIPALLY OWNED PROPERTY DESIGNATED ON THE TAX MAP OF THE BOROUGH OF MANTOLOKING AS BLOCK 24, LOT 5.01

WHEREAS, the Borough of Mantoloking owns certain property designated on the tax map of the Borough of Mantoloking as Block 24, Lot 5.01, also known as 1030 Ocean Avenue; and

WHEREAS the governing body has determined that this property is not needed for public use; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Mantoloking desires to make available for sale by auction said lands to adjacent property owners pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13.2.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Borough of Mantoloking, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. That the property designated on the tax map of the Borough of Mantoloking as Block 24, Lot 5.01 shall be sold at auction at a time and place as fixed by the Borough Clerk.
2. That the minimum bid for said property shall be \$39,200.00.
3. That the purchaser shall be required to pay all of the Borough’s fees associated with the sale, including, but not limited to, closing costs, legal advertising costs and attorneys’ fees.
4. That, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12-13, the governing body reserves the right to reject any and all bids on said properties.
5. That a notice of said sale shall be published in the official newspaper of the municipality on two (2) occasions, at least once a week during two (2) consecutive weeks, the last publication to be not earlier than seven (7) days prior to such public sale.
6. All sales are subject to final approval by adoption of a resolution approving same by the Borough Council.
7. Successful bidders are required to deposit cash or check in an amount not less than 10% of the bid price at the time of sale.

8. Payment in full shall be made upon closing, in cash or by certified check.
9. No person who is delinquent in the payment of taxes or other municipal charges on any other property located in the Borough of Mantoloking shall be permitted to bid for any property to be sold by the Borough of Mantoloking.
10. All bids must be made in increments of \$100.00.
11. No real estate or legal commission shall be paid by the Borough of Mantoloking.

C. RESOLUTION NO. 12/18/2018-06: OF THE BOROUGH OF MANTOLOKING, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING AN EXTENSION OF TWO PROFESSIONAL CONTRACTS

WHEREAS, the Borough of Mantoloking has previously engaged B.L.D.G Architecture, LLC and Sibilia Construction Services, LLC to provide architectural and construction project manager services, respectively, in connection with the design and construction of the new Borough Hall; and

WHEREAS, due to multiple factors, the construction of the new Borough Hall has extended beyond the anticipated time frame and the Borough therefore has a continuing need for the provision of architectural and construction project manager services and has requested proposals by the current professionals supplying those services; and

WHEREAS, B.L.D.G Architecture, LLC and Sibilia Construction Services, LLC have provided the requested proposals for review by the Chief Financial Officer, the Borough Attorney and the Finance and Building Committees and agreements will be provided the the governing body for review and approval at the December 2018 meeting; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the governing body to authorize extension of the existing contractual arrangements with B.L.D.G Architecture, LLC and Sibilia Construction Services, LLC under the existing contracts through May 31, 2019 so that there will be no suspension of these critical professional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Borough of Mantoloking as follows,

1. The previously-authorized contracts between the Borough of Mantoloking and B.L.D.G Architecture, LLC and Sibilia Construction Services, LLC are hereby extended through May 31, 2019.

WHEREAS, the Borough’s insurance carrier and Counsel assigned to the Borough by its insurance carrier, have determined that it is in the best interests of the Borough to settle the pending litigation, in exchange for a release of all claims against the Borough and its officers and employees by the plaintiff; and

WHEREAS, the governing body wishes to authorize the Settlement Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Borough of Mantoloking as follows,

1. That the Settlement of the Barcus v. Borough of Mantoloking, et al, Superior Court, Law Division – Ocean County, Docket No. OCN-L-300-15 litigation, as embodied in the Settlement Agreement, attached hereto, is approved in substantially the form in which it appears as appended to this Resolution.
2. That the Mayor and Clerk are hereby authorized to execute and attest to any necessary documents in order to effectuate the settlement of litigation in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Settlement Agreement.
3. That Eric J. Nemeth, General Counsel, NJIIF is authorized to execute a Stipulation of Dismissal on behalf of the Borough.

Eric Nemeth, Esq. and Dominic Bratti, Esq. from the NJIIF advise the public on the John Barcus vs. The Borough of Mantoloking settlement. They have been defending the claims of Lt. Barcus for close to four years with tons of attorney time hours. This is a whistle blower claim. We feel the Borough had strong defenses of winning the issues in this case, however, if we lose one claim we would be responsible to pay his lawyer’s fees. Settling the matter provides control. The borough will be able to move on. We decided as a JIIF that this matter be settled.

Joann Lygas, 970 Barnegat Lane, wanted to know what the settlement cost the borough, and what steps have been taken to stop this in the future.

Mr. Nemeth responded that we can’t control people, but resolving this case and under Chief Ferris’s management of this department, we are less likely to have this problem going forward. We are also in the process of implementing a new employee manual and employee training programs.

Councilman Rzemieniewski asked what is the amount of counsel fees. Mr. Nemeth responded that there is a \$5,000.00 deductible.

10. **DUNE & BEACH COMMITTEE**: Councilman Nelson presented the reports of the Dune & Beach Committee and Ocean County Block Grant Program.

Councilman Nelson had nothing to report. He advised that he will not be at the next meeting.

11. **MUNICIPAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE** Councilman Amarante stated no report the report of the Mantoloking Relations Committee.

12. **MAYOR AND COUNCIL COMMENTS**

Mayor Nebel thanked the group that put the Christmas Tree Lighting together and also Dick Goldman and Priscilla Hiby. It was a very nice event.

Mayor Nebel also let the public know that this is the last meeting for the news reporter for the Ocean Star, Michael Nunes. We enjoyed having him here.

Councilman Rzemieniewski thanked former Councilwoman O'Mealia for her service and is sorry to see her leave. Councilman White added he feels the same.

Councilman White read Councilwoman O'Mealia's letter to the public regarding her resignation.

Brad Batcha 985 Ocean Avenue, had questions about recycling.

Clerk Konopada advised that the information regarding recycling is on the website and Claudia Larsen is working to notify the public. No plastic bags will be accepted, recycling should be loose in cans.

Peter Flihan, 1105 Barnegat Lane, said within a short period of time plastic bags will be gone. We should start working on it now.

Priscilla Hiby, 907 Barnegat Lane, thanked Don Ness for stepping up to the plate in replacing Councilwoman O'Mealia's term. We know his experience and we are happy.

Connie Pilling, 1 Arnold Street, said she sees the garbage company taking garbage and recycling together.

Clerk Konopada explained if they missed your recycling they sometimes pick up at the same time as regular garbage and put it to the side.
