RESOLUTION CANCELING TAXES ON BOROUGH OWNED PROPERTY KNOWN AS BLOCK 23, LOT 57.01, BLOCK 26, LOT 11.01, BLOCK 35, LOT 11.01, AND BLOCK 36, LOT 11.01

WHEREAS, Block 23, Lot 57.01, Block 26, Lot 11.01, Block 35, Lot 11.01 and Block 36, Lot 11.01 were acquired by the Borough of Mantoloking by deed dated June 22, 2019 which was recorded in the Office of the County Clerk on July 15, 2019 in deed book 17535, page 1022, and;

WHEREAS, there were open taxes for the second and third quarters of 2019 that need to be cancelled in the amounts listed below.

INTRODUCTION TO BOND ORDINANCE NO. 698

BOND ORDINANCE REAPPROPRIATING \$128,000 IN EXCESS BOND PROCEEDS NOT NEEDED FOR THEIR ORIGINAL PURPOSES IN ORDER TO FINANCE THE COST OF THE PURCHASE SELF-CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS AIR PACKS, AND RADIOS AND A SPORTS UTILITY VEHICLE FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND REPEALING BOND ORDINANCE NO. 693 ADOPTED ON AUGUST 20, 2019, AUTHORIZED IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF MANTOLOKING, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Mantoloking, in the County of Ocean, New Jersey (the "Borough") finally adopted Bond Ordinance No. 581 on April 19, 2010, Bond Ordinance No. 566 on May 18, 2009, Bond Ordinance No. 585 on April 19, 2010, Bond Ordinance No. 600 on April 18, 2011, Bond Ordinance No. 597 on April 18, 2011, Bond Ordinance No. 586 on April 19, 2010, Bond Ordinance No. 598 on April 18, 2011, Bond Ordinance No. 599 on April 18, 2011, Bond Ordinance No. 608 on April 23, 2012, Bond Ordinance 609 adopted on April 23, 2012, Bond Ordinance No. 611 adopted on April 23, 2012, Bond Ordinance No. 644 on May 19, 2015, Bond Ordinance No. 658 on September 20, 2016, Bond Ordinance No. 656 adopted on May 17, 2016 (collectively, the "Ordinances"); and

WHEREAS, following the effective dates of the Ordinances, the Borough issued bonds to fully fund same and to finance the improvements or purposes authorized therein; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has determined that the improvements set forth in the Ordinances have either been completed in full or discontinued as a result of events occurring subsequent to the adoption of the Ordinances, as applicable; and

WHEREAS, there currently remains on deposit in the Borough capital accounts excess bond proceeds in the amount of \$128,000, which excess bond proceeds are allocable to such project improvements in the Ordinances (the “Excess Proceeds”), but are no longer necessary to complete such improvements or purposes authorized therein; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with its statutory powers set forth in section 39 of the Local Bond Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:2-1 et seq. (the “Local Bond Law”), the Borough Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough to reappropriate the Excess Proceeds to finance the cost of the purchase of self-contained breathing apparatus air packs, and radios and a sports utility vehicle for the Police Department, for which improvements bonds may be issued, thereby, decreasing the amount of additional Borough debt to finance such current capital needs; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council now desires to reappropriate the Excess Proceeds to finance the cost of the purchase of self-contained breathing apparatus air packs, and radios and a sports utility vehicle for the Police Department.

WHEREAS, the appropriation of Excess Proceeds herein renders Bond Ordinance No. 693 adopted on August 20, 2019 (the “Former Bond Ordinance”) no longer necessary, the Borough Council now desires to repeal the Former Bond Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF MANTOLOKING, IN THE COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, (not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It is hereby determined that the aggregate amount of \$128,000 of the balance of the total appropriation for capital purposes originally made available pursuant to the following Ordinances of the Borough is no longer necessary for the purposes for which the obligations previously were authorized:

Section 2. The appropriations for the purposes in the amounts set forth in Section 1 hereof are hereby canceled and reappropriated pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:2-39 to other capital purposes as set forth in Section 3 hereof.

Section 3. The aggregate amount of \$128,000, representing the amount referred to in Section 1 hereof, is hereby appropriated to provide for the following capital improvement purposes, together with all purposes necessary, incidental or appurtenant thereto, all as shown on and in accordance with plans, specifications or requisitions therefor on file with or through the Borough Clerk, as finally approved by the governing body of the Borough, and the estimated cost the project is as follows:

<u>Amount to be Appropriated</u>	<u>Purpose</u>
<u>\$ 128,000</u>	To finance the purchase of self-contained breathing apparatus air packs, and radios and a sports utility vehicle for the Police Department

Section 4. The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated:

(a) The purposes described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance are not current expenses and are property or improvements which the Borough may lawfully acquire or make as general improvements, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefited thereby.

(b) The average period of usefulness of said purposes within the limitations of the Local Bond Law and according to the reasonable life thereof computed from the date of said bonds authorized by this bond ordinance is five (5) years.

(c) An aggregate amount not exceeding \$25,000.00 for items of expense listed in and permitted under N.J.S.A. 40A:2-20 is included in the estimated cost indicated herein for the improvement or purpose herein before described.

Section 6. Bond Ordinance No. 693 adopted on August 20, 2019 is repealed.

Section 7. The capital budget of the Borough is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this bond ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 8. The Borough covenants to maintain the exclusion from gross income under section 103(a) of the Code, of the interest on all bond proceeds reappropriated by this bond ordinance.

Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect twenty (20) days after the first publication thereof after final adoption.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MANTOLOKING, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF THE DEED OF DEDICATION AND PERPETUAL PUBLIC ACCESS EASEMENT

WHEREAS, the Borough is the owner or easement holder of certain tracts of land identified as public accessways to tidal waterways; and

WHEREAS, as part of the Municipal Public Access Plan, which the Borough is required to file with the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, the Borough identified several public access ways to tidal waterways, and is required by NJDEP rules to dedicate the lands via a Perpetual Public Access Easement; and

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to grant a perpetual deed of easement, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as “Schedule A,” across the subject property to the State of New Jersey.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the governing body of the Borough of Mantoloking, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. That the governing body does hereby authorize the dedication of a Deed of Dedication and Perpetual Public Access Easement to the State of New Jersey attached hereto as Schedule “A.”

SECTION 2. That the Mayor and the Municipal Clerk are hereby authorized to execute and attest to, respectively, any and all documents necessary to facilitate the transfer of the above-mentioned easement in a form acceptable to the Borough Attorney.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.

ADOPTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 696

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MANTOLOKING, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF MANTOLOKING, SO AS TO AMEND CHAPTER 30 ENTITLED “LAND USE REGULATIONS.”

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mantoloking, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Municipal Code of the Borough of Mantoloking is hereby amended and supplemented so as to amend Chapter 30, entitled “Land Use Regulations,” so as to amend § 30-6.11 entitled “Accessory Use and Accessory Structures” so as to amend subsection (b) entitled “Accessory Structures” so as to amend subsection 7. in its entirety so that it shall read as follows:

7. On-grade air conditioning or HVAC units shall be located within the building envelope and must be landscaped or screened with lattice, open board fence, shrubbery and/or plantings, which still allows for the circulation of air and dispersal of fumes, as to lessen the visual impact of the unit(s).

- a. Mechanical and utility platforms servicing the building, including generator platforms, shall be located within the building envelope, not more than six (6) inches from the principal structure and be considered a part of the building footprint and must be landscaped or screened with lattice, open board fence, shrubbery and/or plantings, which still allows for the circulation of air and dispersal of fumes, as to lessen the visual impact of the unit(s).
- b. Roof mounted equipment on an accessory or principal structure must be recessed into the rooflines to entirely screen the units and shall be located within the building envelope. The open end of the recessed roof platform at the roofline for the mechanical equipment shall be adequately screened with lattice, a parapet wall, or similar architectural elements along the roof line, which will still allow for the circulation of air and dispersal of any fumes, to lessen the visual impact and screen the roof mounted unit(s). No part or section of the platforms for roof mounted mechanical equipment shall extend above or beyond the structure’s roofline.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.

Moved by Councilman Amarante, seconded by Councilman Nelson and approved by unanimous roll call vote.

INTRODUCTION TO ORDINANCE NO. 697

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MANTOLOKING, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF MANTOLOKING, SO AS TO AMEND CHAPTER 30 ENTITLED “LAND USE REGULATIONS.”

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mantoloking, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Municipal Code of the Borough of Mantoloking is hereby amended and supplemented so as to amend Chapter 30, entitled “Land Use Regulations,” so as to amend § 30-2.2, entitled “Definitions; word usage” to add and arrange alphabetically the following term:

PLACE OF ASSEMBLY

Any structure or building devoted to the gathering together of persons for a common reason, such as legislative, religious, civic, educational, recreational or social purposes and that is used as the regular site for traditional services, meetings and/or gatherings of an organized body or community, which services, meetings or gatherings are presided over by the ordained or otherwise officially recognized leader of that body or community. Exempted are incidental, temporary or sporadic meetings attended by a small number of persons such that the character of the zone district in which it is located is not compromised for occupants of properties in that area.

SECTION 2. The Municipal Code of the Borough of Mantoloking is hereby amended and supplemented so as to amend Chapter 30, entitled “Land Use,” so as to amend § 30-6.2, entitled “Residential Zones” to add subsection 4 to subsection (a) as follows:

4. Conditional Uses. As

set forth in Section 30-6.18 of this Chapter.

SECTION 3. The Municipal Code of the Borough of Mantoloking is hereby amended and supplemented so as to amend Chapter 30, entitled “Land Use,” so as to amend § 30-6.3, entitled “Business Zones” to add subsection 4 to subsection (a) as follows: 4. Conditional Uses. As set forth in Section 30-6.18 of this Chapter.

SECTION 4. The Municipal Code of the Borough of Mantoloking is hereby amended and supplemented so as to amend Chapter 30, entitled “Land Use Regulations” so as to add § 30-6.18, entitled “Standards for conditional use permit application” as follows:

A. Places of Assembly. Places of assembly may be permitted as conditional uses in all zoning districts provided that the lot and structures thereon shall adhere to the bulk requirements, standards and restrictions of the zone in which it is located and to the following:

- (1) The applicant shall submit a list of proposed activities and anticipated participants, a timetable reflecting the hours in which each building will be used and any other pertinent uses and activities intended to take place on the site. Catering “eating and drinking” shall not be a primary use of these facilities.
- (2) Off-street parking, loading and vehicular access shall be as follows: Off-street parking space, together with appropriate access thereto, shall be provided on the same lot as the building it is intended to serve in accordance with the standards set forth in § 30-4.4 of this chapter and shall require one off-street parking space for every four (4) seats or for every four (4) persons who may be legally admitted, whichever is greater.
- (3) Signs shall be as specified in § 30-6.14 of this chapter.
- (4) The proposed use shall not cause to emanate from the property any vibration, glare, fumes, or odors detectable by neighboring property owners.
- (5) The quantity and type of solid waste disposal shall be the same as other uses in the zone district.
- (6) Site plan approval is required in accordance with §30-5.5. The site plan shall be accompanied by a traffic study prepared by a licensed professional engineer traffic consultant indicating the impact of the proposed place of assembly on surrounding roads. It shall include the following elements:
 - a. Estimated peak hourly traffic to be generated by the use.
 - b. Assignment of estimated peak hourly traffic by percentage and volume to surrounding roads.
 - c. Determination of unused capacity of surrounding roads during peak hours.
 - d. Recommendations for necessary road improvements and traffic control devices recommended for public roads surrounding the site.
- (7) Lighting:
 - a. Wherever artificial lighting is used on the premises, said lighting shall be so installed and maintained that no disturbing glare will be visible on adjacent properties or to motorists using the public street. The use of colored lights, which may be mistaken for traffic lights or signals, and artificial lights that change in intensity or produce a flashing or moving effect are hereby prohibited.
 - b. All electrical lighting of parking areas or parking lots shall remain in operation for a maximum of ½ hour after the closing of the place of assembly.

- (8) Noise: The proposed use shall not make or cause to be made any loud, unnecessary or unusual noises or any noise which does or is likely to annoy, disturb, injure, or endanger the comfort, repose, health, peace or safety of others.
- (9) Hours of Operation:
 - a. The facilities may be open Monday through Sunday not earlier than 7:00 a.m. and not later than 10 p.m.
 - b. Exceptions to the hours of operation may be made for religious holidays and celebrations, seasonal celebrations or other special events or occasions subject to the permission of the Mayor and Council.
- (10) Area and Bulk Regulations shall be as set forth in §30, Appendix B of this chapter. The maximum permissible size of a structure depends on the zone in which it will be located. The setbacks, maximum building height and permissible lot coverage are set forth in Appendix A to this chapter.
- (11) Maximum occupancy of any building constructed or utilized as a place of assembly under this chapter shall be determined by the Construction Official, enforcing officer of the State Uniform Construction Code, pursuant to Chapter 13 of the Municipal Code.
- (12) Applicability of the remainder of Code: Places of assembly must comply with all applicable standards and regulations established by the Code of the Borough, except to those standards and regulations specifically addressed by this section.

B. Reserved.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 6. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 7. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.

VOICE VOTE ORDINANCE 697

Councilman Nelson motioned to table Ordinance 697, the motion was seconded by Councilman Gillingham and approved by unanimous voice vote.

- 11. **MUNICIPAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE** Councilman Rzemieniewski stated no report of the Mantoloking Relations Committee.

12. **STRATEGIC PLANNING COMMITTEE** Councilman Nelson presented the report of the Strategic Planning Committee.

Councilman Nelson reported that Chris Cotter met with Department Heads and is now in phase two of the project. Mr. Cotter's report should be available by the next council meeting.

13. **ENVIRONMENTAL COMMITTEE** Councilman Batcha presented the report of the Environmental Committee.

Councilman Batcha reported that the Environmental Commission passed a resolution to support Choose to Reuse, a statewide initiative for single use disposal bags and encourage residents to use their own reusable bags. He asked the Borough Council to consider this.

The Environmental Commission is strongly in favor of retaining the police boat.

INTRODUCTION TO ORDINANCE NO. 699

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF MANTOLOKING, COUNTY OF OCEAN, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE BOROUGH CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF MANTOLOKING, SO AS TO AMEND CHAPTER 2 ENTITLED "BOARDS, COMMITTEES AND COMMISSIONS" IN ORDER TO ESTABLISH A GREEN TEAM ADVISORY COMMITTEE

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Mantoloking, County of Ocean, and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Municipal Code of the Borough of Mantoloking is hereby amended and supplemented so as to amend Chapter 2, entitled "Boards, Committees and Commissions," so as to add § 2-36, which shall be entitled "Green Team Advisory Committee" which shall read as follows:

§ 2-36.1 Established.

There is hereby established a Green Team Advisory Committee to the Mantoloking Borough Council.

§ 2-36.2 Purpose.

The general purpose for the Green Team Advisory Committee includes but is not limited to the following:

- A.** Manage the Borough's participation in the Sustainable Jersey program;
- B.** Encourage the pursuit of sustainable practices where possible within the Township;
- C.** Make Green Team information available to the public;
- D.** At the recommendation of the Borough Council, work with existing groups within the Township whose actions affect environmental issues;

- E. Provide suggestions for further research and action to the Borough Council;
- F. Solicit and evaluate environmental ideas and suggestions from the community; and
- G. Promote sustainability within the Borough.

§ 2-36.3 Membership; term.

- A. The Green Team shall consist of the members of the Mantoloking Environmental Commission.
- B. Membership on the Green Team shall be concurrent with membership on the Environmental Commission.

§ 2-36.4 Duties.

- A. The Green Team shall adopt schedule of regular meetings and submit same to the Borough Council.
- B. The Green Team shall select volunteers to work on Green Team projects.
- C. The Green Team shall periodically submit reports and minutes to the Borough Council.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision, and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect after second reading and publication as required by law.

ROLL CALL VOTE ORDINANCE 699

Moved by Councilman Batcha, seconded by Councilman Nelson and approved by unanimous roll call vote.

14. MAYOR AND COUNCIL COMMENTS

Councilman Rzemieniewski inquired if it makes sense to keep the patrol boat. Chief Ferris responded that they are only able to enforce 200 feet into the bay. The boat needs a minimum of \$17,000 for repairs to the engine. A new Engine will cost \$50,000. Several different options are being explored.

Councilman Batcha wanted to know if it works from a public standpoint. Chief indicated it is a visual deterrent. The boat was operational on Friday, Saturday and Sunday only.

Foster Voorhees, President of the Fire Department, spoke about the need to purchase a smaller mini pumper fire truck. The larger Arial ladder truck only has a 25 year life and needs to be decommissioned by law. The ladder truck will be sold at auction. A smaller truck only requires 2 people to use it and it can get into all driveways in town.

Public Works Manager, Scott Hulse reported that Point Pleasant Beach and Point Pleasant Borough respond to fires in Mantoloking. Mayor White added that three to five trucks respond to structure fires.

Councilman Amarante received phone calls and had a preliminary meeting regarding the purchase of a new truck. He has not received a quote for a new vehicle to date.

Councilman Rzemieniewski discussed the dangers of phone scams and protecting your families who unknowingly fall victim to these scams. Chief Ferris further explained that you should never give money to anybody who calls you over the phone.

Connie Pilling, 1 Arnold Street, asked if she can dial 311, Chief Ferris replied it is not a local number and to call or text 911.

Priscilla Hiby, 907 Barnegat Lane, discussed the flooding issue at the north end of Barnegat Lane. Mayor White responded to Ms. Hiby that he is working with Mayor Curtis and Larry Plevier. He meets with local Mayors every month and their towns all suffer from the back bay flooding as well.

Chief Ferris explained that during flooding a resident may need to move their car to higher ground and park illegally. Call the Police if you need assistance getting in and out of your homes.

Councilman Nelson suggested residents indicate that they live in a flood area on the We Care Form.

15. PUBLIC COMMENTS PERIOD

Jeb Corbet, 958 East Avenue, people slow down on the bay when they see the police, people were killed years ago when two boats collided on 4th of July.

Jan O'Malley, 1231 Bay Avenue, asked if Bay Head's Ladder Truck maneuvers the driveways on new houses on the beach.

Joanne Lygas, 970 Barnegat Lane, asked if modifications would need to be made to the fire house, how many fire personnel respond to calls and partnering with other municipalities for service.

Carole Leone, 1019 Ocean Avenue, requested to make Lyman Street one way and for a Moby Mat to be placed at Lyman Beach Access.

Chief Ferris reported that Larry Plevier, Borough Engineer, sent a letter to the DOT regarding Lyman Street.

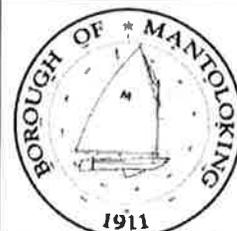

WHEREAS, Grantor is the owner or easement holder of certain tracts of land, located in the Borough of Mantoloking, County of Ocean, State of New Jersey, identified as public access ways located at See attached Table 1 (list of access points and ID #s : A-1 through A-27) as identified in Table 1- Mantoloking Borough Public Access Location (attached , access ways descriptions) and shown on the attached Borough of Mantoloking Municipal Public Access Plan (dated 3-21-2019) consistent with the official tax map of the Borough of Mantoloking, hereinafter the "Property(s);" and Grantor holds the requisite interest to grant this Deed of Easement; and

WHEREAS, the Grantees recognize that tidal waterways and their coastlines at Mantoloking, New Jersey are valuable economic resources to the municipality and the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, access to tidal waterways at Mantoloking, New Jersey is a right provided to the public under the Public Trust Doctrine; and

WHEREAS, in order for the public to access tidal waterways, perpendicular access to these areas must be secured for public use; and

WHEREAS, in order to ensure public access, Grantees need a Perpetual Public Access Easement on portions of said Property(s) herein described; and

WHEREAS, the Borough shall consider this Deed of Easement in establishing the assessed value of any lands subject to such restrictions; and

WHEREAS, this Deed of Dedication and Perpetual Public Access Easement shall be subject to and consistent with any existing public access agreement or easement entered into by the Municipality with the United States Army Corps of Engineers; and

WHEREAS, this Deed of Easement will also serve to implement the Public Trust Doctrine and ensure permanent public access, use and enjoyment of tidal waterways and their shores.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Grantor grants and conveys to Grantee an irrevocable, assignable, perpetual and permanent easement as set forth herein:

GRANT OF EASEMENT: A perpetual and assignable easement and right-of-way across that land of the Property(s) described as public street ends and other locations shown on the attached chart identified as Table 1 - Mantoloking Borough Public Access Location (attached with access ways descriptions: A-1 through A-27) and Mantoloking's Municipal Public Access Plan (MPAP) (attached, dated 3-21-2019) consistent with the official 2019 tax map of the Borough of Mantoloking, hereinafter the "Property(s)," and Grantor holds the requisite interest to grant this Deed of Easement listed above for use by the State of New Jersey and the Borough of Mantoloking, their representatives, agents, contractors and assigns to:

- a. Construct, preserve, patrol, operate, maintain, repair, rehabilitate, and replace a public access area to allow the public access to tidal waterways;
- b. Post signs;

The easement reserves to the Grantor, the Grantor's, successors and assigns the right and privileges as may be used and enjoyed without interfering with or abridging the rights and easements hereby conveyed to the Grantees, subject however to existing easements for utilities and pipelines, existing public highways, existing paved public roads and existing public streets.

Duration of Easement: The easement granted hereby shall be in perpetuity, and in the event that the Borough or the State of New Jersey shall become merged with any other geopolitical entity or entities, the easement granted hereby shall run in favor of surviving entities. The covenants, terms, conditions and restrictions of this Deed of Easement shall be binding upon, and inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their respective representatives, successors and assigns and shall continue as a servitude running in perpetuity with the land.

Municipality to Maintain Public Access: The Borough agrees, consistent with all Federal, State and local statutes and regulations, that at all times it shall use its best, good-faith efforts to preserve, cause and ensure the public access areas to be maintained, consistent with all applicable Federal, State or local laws or regulations, notwithstanding any action or inaction of the State of New Jersey.

Character of Property(s): Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing herein is intended or shall be deemed to grant the Grantees or otherwise permit the Grantee to any other person to cross over or use any part of the Property(s) which is not within the Easement Area; nothing herein is intended or shall be deemed to alter the boundary lines or setback lines of the Property(s).

By the acceptance of this Deed of Easement, the Borough agrees, to the extent allowed by applicable law, that the Property(s) burdened by the easement herein described shall not be excluded from the calculations of minimum square footage requirements when construing applications under the Zoning Ordinance of the Borough.

Miscellaneous:

1. The enforcement of the terms of this Easement shall be at the discretion of the Grantees and any forbearance by Grantees to exercise their rights under this Easement in the event of any violation by Grantor shall not be deemed or construed to be a waiver by Grantee of such term or of any subsequent violation or of any of Grantees rights under this Easement. No delay or omission by Grantees in the exercise of any right or remedy upon any violation by Grantor shall impair such rights or remedies or be construed as a waiver of such rights or remedies.
2. The interpretation and performance of this Deed of Easement shall be governed by the laws of the State of New Jersey.
3. If any provisions of this Deed of Easement or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is found to invalid, the remainder of the provision of this Easement or the application of such provisions to person or circumstances other than those to which it is found to be invalid, as the case may be, shall not be affected thereby.
4. Any notice, demand, request, consent, approval or communication under this Deed of Easement shall be sent by regular first-class mail, postage prepaid and by Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested, addressed to the mailing addresses set forth above or any other address of which the relocation party shall notify the other, in writing.
5. The captions in this Deed of Easement have been inserted solely for convenience of reference and are not a part of this instrument and shall have no effect upon its construction or interpretation.
6. Structures no part of the project are not authorized.
