

Borough of Mantoloking Emergency Proclamation

WHEREAS, on April 8, 2020, Governor Murphy issued Executive Orders 122, restricting construction during the COVID-19 Emergency to essential construction projects; and

WHEREAS, physical operations of all non-essential construction projects are required to cease by 8:00 p.m. on Friday, April 10, 2020; and

WHEREAS, as authorized by Executive Order 122, the Borough of Mantoloking hereby requires that any entity seeking to continue construction activities on a project within the Borough submit contracts for the project to the Construction Office for review and approval as an "essential construction project" prior to continuing any construction activities after April 10, 2020.

In accordance with the power vested in me pursuant to N.J.S.A. App. A:9-40.5, I, Robert McIntyre, Emergency Management Coordinator for the Borough of Mantoloking do hereby order as follows:

1. The Borough of Mantoloking shall implement Executive Order 122, issued by Governor Murphy.
2. That any entity seeking to continue a construction project within the Borough of Mantoloking after April 10, 2020, shall submit for review and approval a contract evidencing that the project is considered an "Essential construction project" under EO 122, such projects include, but are not limited to; residential projects that are exclusively designated as affordable housing; projects already underway involving individual single family homes with a construction crew of 5 or fewer members; and projects already underway involving a residential unit for which a tenant or buyer has already entered into a legally binding agreement to occupy the unit by a certain date, and construction is necessary to ensure the unit's availability by that date.
3. That no construction work may continue within the Borough following April 10, 2020, unless the project has been reviewed and approved as an Essential construction project under the provisions of Executive Order 122.
4. Violation of this order may be punishable, and aiding and abetting violations of this order shall be adjudged as a disorderly person's offense, punishable with imprisonment for a term not to exceed 6 months or a fine not to exceed \$1,000.00 or both.
5. That this Proclamation shall remain in force and effect beginning 8:00p.m. on April 10, 2020 until revoked or modified by the Governor.
