Meeting Minutes

2020 Roots for Rivers Reforestation Grant

- Need to spend \$69.70 in surplus money.
- The order with Pinelands Nursery will be placed shortly for 6 or 7 plants (Winter Berries & Bay Berries) depending on whether they give us a discount or not. Each one-gallon plant is approximately \$10.
- According to Beth, the Bay Berries we planted at Princeton and Downer are doing quite well. The bunny guards may have hurt the Winter Berries when they were planted.
- (As an aside) The eighteen Beach Plums, donated by the Pinelands Preservation Alliance, that were planted at the Downer Beach access point are doing extremely well.
- The final report on this grant is due by 4/30/21.
