## **Meeting Minutes**

#### **MEC/Green Team Regular Business**

#### **Planning Board:**

- Barbara B. thanked Beth N. for her long and excellent service on the MEC. She has resigned from the MEC due to inherent potential conflict between serving on both the Planning Board and the MEC.
- Beth N.'s resignation will enable the finalization of the communication protocol between the MEC and the Planning Board regarding Planning Board applications. The draft protocol will be reviewed at the next MEC meeting and, if approved, incorporated into the ERI as a 2023 update to Recommendation 6.1.2.
- Planning Board hearing(s) relative to the adoption of an amended Master Plan Reexamination report, potentially including the ERI, will be held over the summer.
- There is currently no new business at the Planning Board but two applications are expected for the June meeting.

#### Swan Point Oyster Array (Preservation of Swan Point Project)

Jan informed the commission that there is no update at this time.

#### Patty Brand Memorial Garden Shoreline Protection & Garden Maintenance

 Barbara B met with Joan Mattia and Scott Hulse (DPW). Scott will continue to maintain the Garden. He has already planted Spartina in the core logs.

 There was a discussion regarding the establishment of a more specific annual maintenance plan, which would be approved by the MEC Chair in consultation with Seaweeder Representative, which is now Lauren Fasolo. Joan Mattia has officially stepped down but will continue to be involved as a peripheral level.

#### **Sustainable Jersey PSEG Grant**

- The "Mantoloking Guide to Living in Harmony with Our Environment" is complete and available in the Borough Hall. This is the final project funded by the PSEG Grant. It will be distributed along with the Blue Books and Mantoloking Residential Guide.
- The final report on the PSEG Grant was submitted 5/20/23. It is due on 5/31/23.

# **2023** Calendar (No changes in calendar since the last meeting.) Past:

- April 15: COA Beach Clean-up: 10 people participated and cleaned the entire beach.
- April 22 (Earth Day) Community Tree Distribution: 222 seedlings were allocated to Mantoloking. Barbara B. and John M. managed the distribution table. 12-15 families picked up seedlings. Some remaining seedlings were distributed at the Barnegat Bay Blitz.
- April 22: Barnegat Bay Blitz; about 15 people participated.
  Future:
- July 4<sup>th</sup> Town wide Celebration and Parade: A table will be set up at MYC around 11:30 and will include give aways, perhaps bubbles, water bottles or seeds, in addition to continued messaging as to the use of Native Plants and Pollinators to help butterflies & bees. Jan will liaise with MYC.

Another theme (4Rs – Reduce, Reuse, Recycle, Refuse (e.g., straws)) to attract attention and participation is to develop a recycling game that illustrates some of the items that confuse people as to their recyclability. John W. will bring this to the June meeting for review.

- DRIFT showing update: Beth has proposed a date to Save Barnegat Bay but the date is not vet confirmed.
