The MEC has reviewed the application to the NJDEP for a freshwater wetlands statewide general permit #6 for the project at 915 Barnegat Lane (Blk 14, Tax Lot 6), Borough of Mantoloking, NJDEP File 1519-21-004.1 This application is adamantly opposed and we desire the town engineer's assistance in drafting & sending letter of opposition.

Japanese Black Pine & Crepe Myrtle Maintenance

 John W. reported that there are about 30 Crepe Myrtles in the DOT right of way along Route 35 (on the north end of town from Bay Head through Herbert St.) that
