COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

Public Comment periods provide an opportunity for citizens to express opinions, raise issues, and provide information to elected officials. Public comments are welcome during:

- Caucus Meetings on any municipality-related issues;
- Privilege of the Floor on any agenda item;
- Public Comment Period;
- Public Hearings, e.g., on ordinances.

Once recognized by the Mayor, begin your statement by providing your name and address for the record. If an in-person meeting, please use the microphone provided. If a virtual meeting, once you have finished speaking, please place your phone on mute. When possible, please refrain from using your speaker phone as it creates excess background noise.

Tips for Successful Comments

Meetings run best when everyone respects common courtesy and decorum.

- Be open and honest.
- Keep your comments, brief, clear and focused.
- The chair has the right to cut off discussion that is too personal, too loud, or too crude.
- Respect the views of others.
- Allow others to finish speaking before commenting.
