ENVIRONMENTAL COMMITTEE Councilwoman O'Mealia presented the report of the

Environmental Committee.

Councilwoman O'Mealia advised that there has been some progress with Republics. They will not be collecting cardboard and recyclables on Mondays, only Wednesdays. Bulk pickup items will be picked up the last Thursday of the month.

10. MUNICIPAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE Councilman Rzemieniewski was excused from the meeting.

11. MAYOR AND COUNCIL COMMENTS

Mayor Nebel announced that the County Tax Bill Rate increased three tenths of a cent from 69.4 to 69.7. He also advised that the tax bills have been mailed. The last day to pay taxes before being charged interest is September 11, 2017.

Sewer bills were sent out on April 28, 2017. Payment needs to be received by August 17, 2017. If received late, interest dates back to April 28, 2017.

Council President White advised the public that the beach ordinance was not ready yet and therefore was removed from the agenda. The ordinance will be reintroduced next month. He also indicated that an appeals board would be set up. He notified the public that Robert Mainberger was present to answer questions regarding the Dune and Beach Ordinance.

12. PUBLIC COMMENTS PERIOD

The status of homes with mold.

Pictures of foundations being taken of Ocean Front properties.

Resident concerned about fill on neighbor's property and the profile of the dune

He was advised that the Borough Engineer issued a letter to neighbor and contractor regarding material. Mayor Nebel advised that the dune profile will be addressed by the Borough Engineer. Elevated walk way issue on seaward dune (dune deck)

Homeowner resprentative looking to have the ordinance changed to allow multiple dune decks and walkways as opposed to one.

Robert Mainberger updated the residents regarding the Army Corp. meeting with Weeks Marine. Projected milestones may vary. Anticipated arrival of equipment on September 20, 2017. Seismic monitoring will be conducted. Survey work to be performed on Monday or Tuesday the 22nd or the 23rd that will determine beach conditions and where the actual dune ties into dune on the westerly side. Stakes will be placed where the work will be done. Contractor will make the decision on option 11 up to Stephens. Pipeline North of Downer.
