## RECYCLE THESE ITEMS!



### **PAPER** CLEAN & DRY

- Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs
- Non-Metallic Wrapping Paper, Tissue Paper
- Paper Bags, Paperback Books
- Mixed Paper, Office Folders, Mail



### **CARDBOARD** CLEAN, DRY & FLAT

- Corrugated Cardboard
- Boxboard / Chipboard
- Rolls from Toilet Paper, Paper Towels and Wrapping Paper



### **GLASS & METAL** CLEAN & DRY

- Empty Non-Hazardous Aerosol Cans
- Bottles, Jars, Jugs
- Aluminum Foil and Trays
- Tin, Aluminum, Steel Cans



### **PLASTIC** CLEAN & DRY Labeled 1, 2 or 5

- Plastic Bottles and Caps
- Take-Out Rigid Containers
- Dairy Containers and Lids
- Fast Food Beverage Cups and Lids

# LEAVE 'EM OUT!

## THESE ITEMS DO NOT BELONG IN THE RECYCLING BIN.

This is only a partial List - When in doubt, throw it out.



### NO PLASTIC BAGS

Bring to grocery store for special recycling.



### NO ELECTRONICS

Bring to the OC Northern Recycling Center.



### NO BATTERIES

Non-Rechargeable: throw in the trash.  
Button: Bring to Hazardous Waste Event.  
Rechargeable: use the Call2Recycle® drop box at the OC Northern Recycling Center.



### NO HAZARDOUS WASTE

Such as pool chemicals, fire extinguishers, cleaning products, fertilizers, pesticides, etc.  
Bring to Hazardous Waste Event.



### NO STYROFOAM

Throw in the trash.



### NO PAINT (SPRAY OR CAN)

Bring to the OC Northern Recycling Center.



### NO WAXED CONTAINERS

Throw wax paper and wax coated containers in the trash.



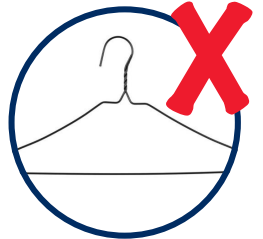
### NO SHREDDED PAPER

Bring to Document Shredding Event or throw in the trash.



### NO BULBS

Bring fluorescent bulbs to Hazardous Waste Event. Otherwise, throw in the trash.



### NO WIRE HANGERS

Bring to a local dry cleaner or throw in the trash.



### NO TIRES

Bring to Ocean County Remanufacturing Center.

You can dispose of up to 10 tires at \$2 per tire
